

Bonfire Rules & Expectations

Rules:

- No substances (e.g., alcohol, marijuana, tobacco) are permitted within the ALTITUDE compound, and should not be consumed during the bonfire
- Please do not throw objects into the fire
- Please do not feed the fire an ALTITUDE staff will be present to maintain your bonfire during the duration of your booking.
- No horseplay around the bonfire area.

What to bring:

- Snacks are highly encouraged for your bonfire!
- Roasting sticks for snacks are encouraged (we do have some however you may want to bring more).
- Small bluetooth speakers are allowed (if music is too loud, our staff will kindly ask you to turn it down)

What not to bring:

- Loudspeakers (due to noise restrictions, we cannot accommodate loud music in our space)
- Fireworks and/or sparklers
- Excessive amounts of food packaging (if you are bringing snacks, please ensure to clean to up after yourselves and place packaging in recycling or garbage)

What to expect from our staff:

- They will maintain the fire during the duration of your event
- They will monitor participants to ensure all safety rules are being followed
- Staff will arrive 30 minutes prior to the event to get the fire started, you can arrive at this
 time to set up if would like, however please be aware the fire will not be ready until your
 official start time

What to and not to expect from our facility:

- We do not have outlets or access to power at the ALTITUDE compound
- We do not provide any additional lighting, our area is lit by the fire and street lighting
- We do have 6 picnic tables that you can use for your event (if you choose to move them, please make sure you place them back at the end of the event)
